Both seacocks need serviced. Will not move/can't shut them off! We will resolve before the

boat goes into the water. Bilge suction valve tapered square has been cut off, new handles

need hole enlarged or valve needs square cut down.

Found missing port engine dipstick hanging on shield plate. Re installed. Lubed fuel fill plugs.

Truck needed primed (again) need to get 10mm wrench for bleeder screw. Trailer organized for Ft. Lewis and beyond.
